Membership Terms and Conditions

Membership contract and cancellation policy

Membership is of the Nantwich Agricultural Society, which includes and supports the educational work of the Society.

Membership costs are subject to change on an annual basis and will be communicated with our Members prior to renewal.

Membership runs annually from 1st January to 31st December and is valid for one year. Pro-rata refunds will not be given should the Membership be terminated prior to expiry. Membership renews on 1st January and the Nantwich Agricultural Society reserve the right to include a late payment charge for any Memberships that are renewed after 1st May.

Memberships are non-transferable and non-refundable other than in exceptional circumstances where they have been requested in writing and you have received written confirmation of your request from the Nantwich Agricultural Society.

It is the Members responsibility to renew their Membership annually and to update the Nantwich Agricultural Society of any contact detail changes. The Nantwich Agricultural Society will endeavour to send reminders where possible.

Member Benefits

Free of charge or discounted tickets and offers received as part of the Membership should be used by Members only and are not transferrable to other individuals.

The Nantwich Agricultural Society reserve the right to change or adapt the benefits given to its Members at any time and without prior notice.

Dress Code

Vice Presidents and Members are kindly asked to follow the dress code policy (see below) to gain access to these areas.

Vice Presidents

Vice Presidents are required to wear a jacket and tie or skirts, summer dresses and well-cut trousers.

Members

Members are required to wear collared shirt and smart trousers – tailored shorts are permitted, or skirts and summer dresses.

Fashion style trainers and converse style shoes are permitted.
