### **Terms and Conditions**

## Riders 🕮

- Must be wearing correctly fitting and secured hat up to standard PAS 015 or equivalent when mounted, as well as proper riding attire and boots.
- Excessive use of whips or spurs are not allowed, and the organisers reserve the right to ask any riders behaving as such to leave.
- Rider numbers must be worn, and will be provided at sign in.
- Riders must have a minimum of Third-Party Insurance and take part at their own risk.
- Riders under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult, with a maximum of two junior riders per adult.
- Any rider not deemed to be behaving appropriately will be asked to leave by organisers.
- Riders are advised to carry a map, and MUST stick to the marked trail, not taking any shortcuts.
- Riders should ride at a walk down any very steep, rocky or slippery terrain.
- Riders should keep a safe distance between themselves and those in front of them and behind.
- Riders must report any incidents or hazards to the event organisers.
- Riders must follow any instructions given by organisers, stewards, first aid personnel or veterinarians.
- Participants leave their vehicles and all belonging unattended at their own risk.
- Well behaved dogs on leads are permitted in the parking areas.
- Walkers with dogs and cyclists accompanying participants are NOT permitted.

## Equines 🐊

- All horses must be wearing suitable, safe and correctly fitting tack.
- All horses MUST BE AT LEAST 4 YEARS OLD and have suitable experience for attending such an event.
- All horses must be under control at all times.
- Stallions permitted and MUST be wearing stallion badge and/ or tail ribbon.
- We encourage the use of tail ribbons to signal to fellow riders, such as, a green ribbon for young/inexperienced horses or a red ribbon for horses that kick/strike.
- All equines must have up to date vaccinations for Equine Influenza.
- Organisers reserve the right to decline participation to any equine who is not deemed to be in an appropriate physical or mental condition.

## Booking Conditions 🗐

- The online booking system will close on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September at 5pm.
- Bookings on the day will be taken at an increased price, space permitting.
- Refunds will be approved up to 48 hours prior to the event, after which no refunds will be given.
- If the event is cancelled by the organiser all fees will be reimburses accordingly. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event at any time if it is deemed unsafe or there are unforeseen circumstances.
- Participants must complete the registration form prior to the event and provide all of the required details.

# Emergencies 500

- All riders must sign in and out of the event in case of emergency.
- An emergency contact number will be provided at the time of sign in; all riders must take this number.
- It is strongly recommended that all riders should carry a form of identification and emergency contact details.
- Riders must carry a mobile phone or method of communication.
- It is advised that any rider that has specific medical details that the emergency services need to be aware of, wears a medical arm band in case of an incident.
- There will be a paramedic or qualified first aider on site.
- There will be a veterinarian on site, and all vet costs will be the responsibility of the rider or owner of the horse.
